

FREE PFIZER COVID-19 VACCINATION AT SCHOOL FOR STUDENTS AGE 5-11

Oconto County Public Health (OCPH) will be at Lena School on **Wednesday 12/15/2021** to provide the 1st dose of vaccine and **Wednesday 1/5/2022** to provide the 2nd dose of vaccine.

Vaccine will be given to students who have turned in a signed and completed consent form.

Please note:

- Only students ages 5-11 are eligible to receive vaccine on these dates.
- OCPH will be at the school from 9:00 a.m.-10:00 a.m. both days. If your child is not in school during this time, a parent/guardian is asked to bring the student into school during this timeframe.
- OCPH will provide 1st doses only on 12/15/2021 and 2nd doses only on 1/5/2022.
- OCPH will provide students with their vaccination card after the student receives their 2nd dose of vaccine.
- For children who will turn 12 in between the 1st and 2nd dose: OCPH will use the vaccine dose that has been authorized for ages 5-11 for both doses which is a smaller dose than the vaccine authorized for ages 12 and up.
- OCPH will not return to the school for absent students.
- If you've turned in a consent form for your child to receive their COVID-19 vaccine at school from OCPH and your child receives their COVID-19 vaccine before OCPH is at school, please call OCPH at 920-834-6846 to let them know.
- Please ensure that the consent form is filled out completely and signed. OCPH will make 1 phone call to reach parents if needed.

Complete and return the consent form to the school office by Friday, December 3, 2021.
